**HEAD**

**5 out of every 6** workers who sustain a head injury aren't wearing a hard hat at the time.

**EYES & EARS**

The average construction worker spends 1/3 of each shift exposed to noise that is **85+ decibels**.

**40%** of workers suffering an eye injury actually are wearing some sort of protection at the time. Just full-face and side shield features are often absent.

**HANDS**

Always work in the designated hand tool area within your work area.

Considering construction workers make a living with their hands, it's no surprise that injuries to the hands are the most common cause of lost work time.

**CLOTHING**

Chassis risks such as water exposure must be addressed with the same degree of attention as those caused by flying objects.

1/3 of all street and highway construction injuries are visibility-related.

High-visibility clothing ensures the job'll be seen by everyone in the construction zone and before it's too late.
